Create

Write a poem, draw a picture, sing a song, direct a video, or perform a skit to teach others about the importance of the Arctic.

Reduce

Make choices that do not require plastic consumption (such as using reusable bags, water bottles, and utensils). And remember to always recycle!

Move

Create a plan to bike, walk, or take public transportation instead of driving, when possible. These alternative modes of transportation will use less energy and help to reduce greenhouse gas emissions.

Plant

Trees absorb carbon from the air and reduce the impacts of climate change around the world. Research what trees are native to your area and get planting!
