Happy Farm to School Month, Food Waste Warriors!

This year, to start the Food Waste Warriors program off with a big BITE, we want to hear from YOU! From now until October 31st, World Wildlife Fund will be accepting posters designed by students in participating Food Waste Warrior schools, in grades K-12. We are looking for posters that inspire others to reduce food waste and promote sustainable practices in schools. We believe in the power of young voices to make a difference, and we can't wait to see your innovative ideas come to life through art!

RULES:

- 1. Theme:** Create a poster or piece of digital media that focuses on the topic of **reducing food waste in school cafeterias**. Your artwork should showcase: practical tips, creative solutions, or awareness about the importance of reducing food waste. We encourage you to get creative with it!
- 2. Eligibility:** This art gallery is open to students from grades Kindergarten through 12th Grade.
- 3. Submission Guidelines:**
 - **Format:** Design your poster on a standard letter-sized (8.5" x 11") paper or digitally.
 - **Medium:** Use any artistic medium (e.g., markers, crayons, paint) that allows your creativity to shine. We cannot accept posters that use 3D materials (stay away from pom poms, pipe cleaners, buttons, glitter, etc.)
 - **Content:** Ensure your poster is original and does not contain any copyrighted material. Along with your poster, you will submit a quick summary that explains your poster or digital media's message and where you intend to hang it up or showcase the message around your school.

4. Submission Deadline: All entries must be submitted by October 31st, 11:59pm (PST). Late submissions will not be accepted. Each student may only submit one poster or digital media file.

5. Submission Process: Upload a scanned or digital photo of your poster to the submission form provided [HERE](#).

6. Poster Review and Selection: Posters will be reviewed based on creativity, readability, relevance to the theme, visual impact, and clarity of message. Three posters from each grade bracket (K-2, 3-5, 6-8, 9-12) will be selected to share on WWF's Food Waste Warriors and Food Waste Prevention Week's webpages.

7. Ownership: By submitting your poster, you agree that World Wildlife Fund may use your artwork for promotional purposes related to this poster gallery.
