How to fold an origami






1. Start with a square piece of paper – black on one side.




2. Fold and unfold. Turn over.




3. Fold flaps in.




4. Fold flaps behind.




5. Result. Turn over.




6. Fold up.




7. Fold in half.




8. Fold down and unfold.




9. Outside reverse-fold the head.




10. Inside reverse-fold bottom corner.



11. Crimp beak.



12. Fold wing tips out on both sides.
