Walking:

Directions from Dupont Circle Metro (Red Line):

- Exit the Metro via the Dupont **South Exit** escalators onto 19th Street, NW.
- Continue walking west down 19th Street (the Dupont traffic circle will be at your back) until you reach N Street NW.
- Turn right onto N Street and walk 5 blocks to reach 24th Street NW.
- Turn left onto 24th Street—WWF is the second building on the right, 1250 24th Street, NW.
- Walk is approximately ¾ mile, 15 minutes.

Directions from Foggy Bottom Metro (Blue/Orange Line):

- Exit the Metro via the escalators and U-turn to your right through the George Washington University Hospital gates.
- Proceed through the pathway until you reach 24th Street, NW.
- Turn right onto 24th Street and walk approximately 3 blocks to reach the corner of 24th Street and M Street, NW.
- Continue on 24th Street across M Street—WWF is the second building on the left, 1250 24th Street, NW.
- Walk is approximately ½ mile, 10 minutes.

Shuttle to and from Foggy Bottom and Dupont Circle Metro Stations:

The building provides a free shuttle service to and from the Foggy Bottom and Dupont Circle metro stations. The shuttle is available for use by all building occupants and guests. Employee identification may be requested by the driver. There is no cost for employees and their guests. **Morning pickups at the metro stations are between 7–9:40am; afternoon pickups at 1250 24**th **Street, NW are between 4:05–7:20pm.**

The shuttle, identified by an *Reston Limo Service* decal, picks up passengers:

- Outside the WWF Building.
- In front of the Foggy Bottom metro station on 23rd Street
- In front of the Dupont Circle south metro entrance on 19th Street.

From Union Station: You can take Metro (**red line** to Dupont Circle), a cab, or request a rideshare (Uber/Lyft). For more information: <u>https://www.unionstationdc.com</u>

Driving Directions

Directions from Maryland (Baltimore-Washington Parkway):

- From the Baltimore-Washington Parkway exit and merge onto New York Avenue NE.
- New York Avenue NE becomes Mt. Vernon Place NW after 5 miles. Shortly after, Mt. Vernon Place becomes Massachusetts Ave NW.
- Turn Right into Thomas Circle. Travel halfway around the circle and exit onto M Street, NW.
- Continue on M Street for 1 mile until you reach 24th Street, NW.
- Turn right onto 24th Street--WWF is the second building on the left, 1250 24th Street NW.

Directions from Maryland (I-495):

- I-95 south to I-495 (Capital Beltway) toward Silver Spring/Northern Virginia.
- Take exit 33, heading south on Connecticut Avenue for about 10 miles.
- From Connecticut Avenue turn right on N Street NW.
- Continue on N Street until you reach 24th Street, NW—WWF is the second building on the right, 1250 24th Street, NW.

Directions from Virginia (from I-395 North):

- I-95 to I-395 Arlington Memorial Bridge exit.
- Cross the bridge and bear left at the Lincoln Memorial. Turn left onto 23rd Street NW.
- Continue up 23rd Street NW until you reach Washington Circle.
- Turn right at Washington Circle and continue ¾ of the way around the circle and merge right onto Pennsylvania Avenue.
- Quickly turn right onto 24th Street NW-- WWF is the second building on the left, 1250 24th Street NW.

Directions from Virginia (from I-66/Route 50):

- I-66 and Route 50 both connect with the Theodore Roosevelt Bridge.
- Cross the bridge and exit left at E Street, then again at Virginia Avenue.
- Bear left, following signs for 23rd Street.
- Turn right on 23rd Street and continue until you reach Washington Circle.
- Turn right at Washington Circle and continue ¾ of the way around the circle and merge right onto Pennsylvania Avenue.
- Quickly turn right onto 24th Street NW-- WWF is the second building on the left, 1250 24th Street NW.

Parking

WWF-US Headquarters building has a parking garage with limited daily parking from 7:00am – 6:30pm, Monday – Friday, excluding building holidays. The daily parking garage rate is \$15.00. Vehicles must be removed by 6:30 pm (as the steel gates are lowered at this time).

You can also find parking spots/garages in the area via such apps as *Best Parking*, *Parkmobile*, and *SpotHero* which also list fees for each garage.

Street parking (metered) is available in the neighborhood. However, be aware of parking restriction signs.


WWF Reception Lobby — All WWF visitors must sign in at the WWF reception desk.

From Building Front Entrance

Walk up the stairs on the left, go forward until you see the secure door to the WWF Reception lobby on the left.

From the Garage/Elevator

Press button for the 2nd Floor, exit and head towards the security desk at the center of the atrium and then turn right. You'll see the WWF Reception Lobby another 10 feet on the right.



From Local Airports

Dulles International Airport (IAD)

Dulles International Airport is located approximately 28 miles from downtown Washington DC. <u>www.metwashairports.com/dulles/dulles.htm</u>

Metrobus (Bus):

Metrobus runs a DC-Dulles bus (5A) that operates between the airport and the L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station in downtown DC. It makes three other stops along the way. Proceed outside the airport at the departures level to the bus stop area. Look for signs for the 5A bus. The trip between Dulles and the L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station takes about 50 minutes and costs \$6.00 USD. The bus only accepts exact cash. Once at L'Enfant Plaza, you can take the Orange or Blue line to Foggy Bottom. www.wmata.com/bus

Metrorail (Train) plus Shuttle:

Metro trains are not accessible from Dulles International Airport. To get to the Metro, you can take a Washington Flyer shuttle. The Washington Flyer shuttle bus departs Dulles every 30 minutes to the West Falls Church Metro Station. For scheduling information, visit the website listed below. The trip is 20 to 30 minutes and costs \$10.00 one way, \$18 round trip. From West Falls Church, you can take the Orange line to Foggy Bottom. www.washfly.com/flyer_bus_about.htm

<u>Taxi:</u>

Fares will run approximately \$50.00 - \$70.00 USD to downtown Washington. Follow the signs inside the terminal on the arrivals level to the airport taxi stand. Be aware that you should only use taxis sanctioned from the airport taxi stand. <u>www.visitingdc.com/airport/dulles-airport-taxi.htm</u>

Ridesharing:

Uber and Lyft both operate to and from IAD. The fare from IAD to WWF Headquarters will vary based on traffic and surge pricing, but typically an UberX will cost \$37 - \$48 and Lyft will cost \$37 - \$63 USD.

Shuttle Service:

SuperShuttle's door-to-door shared ride van service is available to-and-from the airport. This will cost less than a taxi, but may make multiple stops as the van is shared with other passengers. Make reservation in advance through the SuperShuttle website: <u>www.supershuttle.com</u>

Ronald Reagan National Airport (DCA)

Ronald Reagan National Airport is located approximately 7 miles from downtown Washington DC. <u>www.metwashairports.com/reagan/reagan.htm</u>

Metrorail (Train/ Rail System):

The Blue and Yellow Lines have Metro stops at The Ronald Reagan National Airport. You can take the Blue line to the Foggy Bottom Metro Station, which is close to WWF-US Headquarters. <u>www.wmata.com</u>

<u>Taxi:</u>

Fares will run approximately \$25.00 USD to downtown Washington. Taxicabs are dispatched from convenient locations on the arrivals curb just outside the baggage claim areas of each terminal. Uniformed taxicab dispatchers are stationed at each taxicab dispatch area to assist passengers with selecting a taxicab based on destinations in Washington DC, Virginia, or Maryland. Ridesharing:

Uber and Lyft both operate to and from DCA. The fare from DCA to WWF Headquarters will vary based on traffic and surge pricing, but typically an UberX will cost \$14 - \$18 and Lyft will cost \$11 - \$18 USD.

Shuttle Service:

SuperShuttle's door-to-door shared ride van service is available to-and-from the airport. This can cost less than a taxi, but may make multiple stops as the van is shared with other passengers. Make a reservation in advance through the SuperShuttle website: <u>www.supershuttle.com</u>

Baltimore-Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport (BWI)

Baltimore-Washington International Thurgood Marshall Airport is located 28 miles from downtown Washington DC. <u>www.bwiairport.com</u>

MARC Train to Metro:

MARC Train runs between BWI and Union Station in downtown DC, Monday through Friday only for around \$6.00 one way. The BWI Rail Station is located one mile from the terminal building, and there is a complementary shuttle to the airport terminal. Schedules and shuttle stops are subject to change, so confirm schedules before traveling. At Union Station you can connect to Metro and take the Red Line to DuPont Circle. <u>mta.maryland.gov/marc-train</u>

<u>Taxi:</u>

Fares will run approximately \$80.00 - \$90.00 to downtown Washington DC. The taxi stand is located just outside of the baggage claim area on the Lower Level of the BWI Marshall terminal. Be aware that you should only use taxis sanctioned from the airport taxi stand. www.bwiairporttaxi.com

Ridesharing:

Uber and Lyft both operate to and from BWI. The fare from BWI to WWF Headquarters will vary based on traffic and surge pricing, but typically an UberX will cost \$43 - \$58 and Lyft will cost \$52 - \$79 USD.

Shuttle Service:

SuperShuttle's door-to-door shared ride van service is available to-and-from the airport. This will cost less than a taxi, but may make multiple stops as the van is shared with other passengers. Make reservation in advance through the SuperShuttle website: <u>www.supershuttle.com</u>
