- *To measurably reduce or eliminate key negative impacts of trout farming while ensuring product quality and economic viability.*

FTAD proces has begun

FTAD 1 and 2 (November 2008 and May 2009):

- Objectives and goals of the FTAD
- Ground rules for a transparent and effective FTAD process
- Draft impacts, principles, criteria developed
- Steering committee is formed (7 members)
- Additional steering committee members
