Zoll in Hamburg finds 4.5 tons of cocaine: Largest ever seized in Germany seized single quantity discovered on a container ship

Once again, the customs in Hamburg can record a sensitive blow against international drug-related crime. Two weeks ago, forces at the main customs office in Hamburg, following a previous risk analysis, examined a suspicious container from Montevideo destined for Antwerp. When they opened the container, which according to the Manifesto was loaded with soybeans, they initially saw only a large amount of black sports bags. In the 211 bags, the officials then discovered over 4,200 packets of pressed cocaine. The total weight of the illegal product is 4.5 tons.

Ecological harm = physical not financial crime

- More than \$2 trillion dollars in illegal revenue generated from ecological crimes against fisheries, wildlife and forested areas
- True value remains unknown as ecological services are unvalued and unmonitored save under FDI lens
- Physical act of logging or poaching is reduced by law enforcement to a criminal and physical act where caught with a small fine.
- Delinked from the business model driving the industry, constructed around harmful legal and financial vehicles that camouflage activity
- The role of intermediaries including banks, law firms and secrecy jurisdictions are elided by law enforcement with few STRs or cross-border assistance



To achieve this, the centre also publishes stories in The Namibian and the Mail & Guardian through the M&G Centre for Investigative Journalism (amaBhungane).


Internal financial structure of Beny Steinmetz Group (BSG)







CORRUPTION: WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE?

Country A.

Trafficker: "Bringing these (redacted) to the flight to (redacted) is very easy. They already arranged sending the suitcases into the plane with the help of the airline staff and they have bribed all the staff of the airline in the airport."

Country B.
